Date Read: Today's readers:
What's the first verse?
Who is the letter directed to? (i.e. 1:1):
What is Paul's prayer for the Philippians? What does he want them to have and experience?
When Paul is writing this letter, what is going on in his life? (see 1:12-14)
What does Paul desire for the community/church in Philippi? (see 2:1-5)
2:6-11 is one of the earliest examples of a Christian hymn. What is it about?
In Paul's time, mail needed to be hand delivered. Who does Paul want to send to Philippi?

Chapter 3 talks about "the law." What does you think the law is?
Why does Paul in 3:4-6 mention his past?
What does Paul want to know (see 3:10)?
If a friend asked you to describe faith, what would you say?
Why does Paul continue to reach towards Jesus Christ? (see 3:12)
As Lutherans, we proclaim that faith is a gift from God. After reading Paul's letter to the Philippians, do you believe that? Is your faith a gift? Where does it come from?
